We are really looking forward to starting our new topic 'Enchanted Woodland'!

## Class Topic:

This half term our topic is called 'Enchanted Woodland'.

We will be going on a magical walk on school grounds to find mythical creatures.

We will also be exploring the work of the artist 'Andy Goldsworthy'. We will be making our own sculptures in the style of his work, using a collection of natural materials.



## Science:

This term we will be learning about materials.

We will be identifying a variety of widely used materials and investigating why some materials are chosen for specific tasks. We will be testing material strength and developing an understanding that some materials are natural and others are man-made.

## Maths:

Year 1 will be learning about measurement where we will learn to solve mass, weight and capacity problems. Moving on to learn about multiplication and division and counting in twos, fives and tens.

Year 2 will be learning about measurement, this will include length and height in cm and m. Then moving on to position and direction.



## English:

This half term we will be using two texts 'Little Red Riding Hood' and 'Wild'.

We will be using these texts to help us develop our sentence writing skills. We will be learning about nouns and adjectives and how to use them in our work to make our writing more interesting.



## PE:

This half-term we will be working on developing our balance, co-ordination and agility. We will do this through playing a range of ball games.



## PSHCE & RE:

RE- We will be learning about what it means to belong.

PSHCE- We will be using the Jigsaw scheme. Our next unit of work is called 'Relationships.'

## Music:

We will be learning to play and maintain a steady beat using movements, body percussion and instruments.
