technology to design a cross-sectional diagram of a predator. We will then use the design to help us create a collage using a variety of materials.

Science:

Our topic is 'Rocks. We will explore how mountains and fossils are formed. Learn




to recognise the differences between igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic rocks along with by the end of the topic being able to identify common rocks.

Maths:

This half-term's English text is Mouse, Bird, Snake, Wolf. We will be learning about creations and writing our own character descriptions, exploring poetry and writing a persuasive argument.
