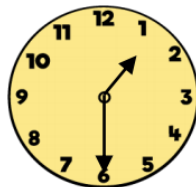
Science:

Our topic is 'Rocks.' We will explore how mountains and fossils are formed. Learn to recognise the differences between igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic rocks along with by the end of the topic being able to identify common rocks.



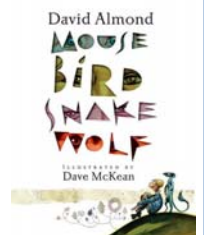
Maths:

This term we will be learning how to recognise and find unit and non-unit fractions. We will be learning how to investigate and record equivalent fractions. We will then move onto the topic of time. Learning about telling the time to the nearest 5 minutes and using both digital and analogue clocks.



English:

This half-term's English text is Mouse, Bird, Snake, Wolf. We will be learning about creations and writing our own character descriptions, exploring poetry and writing a persuasive argument.



VIPERS

We will learn to use the reading skills characterisation and inference when reading our VIPERS text 'The ways of the wolf.'

PE: In our P.E lessons we will be learning how create speed and use explosive strength.

We will use these skills to learn how to use the javelin and gradually improve our technique with improved skill and accuracy.



PSHCE:

In our 'Relationships' topic we will be learning how to identify and practise the skills of friendship, learn to what is means to be a global citizen.

MFL

In French this half-term we will be learning to say and understand fruits, vegetables and breakfast foods. We will also learn how to ask for an item of food.
