We will continue to use Seesaw to document children's learning in EYFS. You will be able to see your child's learning at school, add your own observations and complete home learning activities. Class Topic: The World Around Us! Reception will be exploring the world around us this half term. We will look at Winter weather, exploring the changes around us and compare to the Polar regions. We will be celebrating Chinese New Year and finding out about the dances and food. We will also be exploring which jobs we can see in our community and why recycling is so important to the world around us.		Knowledge and Understanding of the World Exploring winter weather. What do we wear in Winter? What does our environment look like in Winter? Celebrating Chinese New Year. What do the celebrations look like? What food do people eat? Exploring occupations. What jobs can we see in our community? Recycling. What can be recycled and why?
Maths: Exploring numbers 6,7 and 8. Practice writing numbers 1 to 8. Combining 2 numbers. Measuring: Comparing mass. Which is heaviest? Comparing capacity - full, empty, half full, nearly full, nearly empty. Calendar and Time: Days of the Week. Seasons.	 English: The children will be learning stories though 'Talk Through Stories'. We will be reading the stories frequently to get to know them really well and learning the vocabulary in them. The stories this term are: One Snowy Night, Lost and Found and Burglar Bill. Phonics: Children will continue learning letter sounds and how to blend and segment words. They will continue to practice m, a, s, d, t, i, n, g, o, c, k, u, b, f, e, l, h, sh, r, j, v, y, w, th, z, ch, qu, x, ng, nk and build words with these sounds. Eg. s-a-t, sat, b-u-g bug. Name writing: Children will practise recognising and writing their name each day. They will practise forming the letters correctly.
