Many thanks for the positive comments and kind words about the school. In response to some of the comments made we would like to offer the following information:

Communication- We use our online platform of SeeSaw for the majority of our communications. We are aware that some parents have struggled to access the platform. Please let us know if you are having problems with access and our office staff can support you in this. It is also helpful if you put notification alerts on your Seesaw account so it flashes up every time a new communication is added.

Lack of wider experiences and fun activities- Unfortunately due to the pandemic we have had no option but to reduce the number of trips and extra activities over the last two years. As a school we plan for at least one WOW activity per half term per class however due to Covid-19 restrictions these have had to be cancelled. We continue to plan for trips and visitors into school and will go ahead with them wherever possible. This year we have invested in a number of playground resources and trained some of our children to become Play Leaders to allow children to join in with fun and enjoyable activities during their break and lunchtimes. School staff actively encourage children to join in to allow children to enjoy active break times.

There was a comment left by one parent that was concerned around the professionalism of some of our lunchtime staff and teaching assistants. I would like to reassure all parents that all staff have annual safeguarding training and are aware of how to log and report all concerns. Following this comment we have looked at our online reporting system (which monitors and reports any concerns from children and parents) since September 2020 we have had a handful of parents calling us regarding lunchtimes and support staff, these concerns have all been followed up by the Senior Leadership Team and have been resolved to the satisfaction of the parents. We do recognise that they were concerns before the acadamisation of the school, however we are confident that these problems have been resolved. If you are a parent who does not feel an issue has been resolved, I would urge you to make contact with a member of the Senior Leadership Team who are always available on the gate at the beginning and end of the day for an informal chat or to contact the school office to make a formal appointment.

We are unsure what the 'amount of issues and deep seeded problems' with the school are as records dated from September 2020 do not mirror this but we would be more than happy to discuss this directly with the anonymous parent.
