growing. We will be visiting Canon Hall farm to see the animals

and find out about life on a working farm.

We will be observing caterpillars as they grow and change into painted lady butterflies.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World:

Maths: Exploring numbers to 20 and beyond. Building numbers to 20 and counting to 20 and beyond. Addition of numbers to 10. Combining numbers. How many altogether? Subtraction within 10. How many do I have now? Exploring and naming 2D and 3D shapes. Doubling numbers within 10.	 English: The children will be learning stories though 'Talk Through Stories'. We will be reading the stories frequently to get to know them really well and learning the vocabulary in them. The stories this term are: Farmer Duck, Supertato and The Extraordinary Gardener. Phonics: Children will continue learning letter sounds and how to blend and segment words. They will continue to practice m, a, s, d, t, i, n, g, o, c, k, u, b, f, e, l, h, sh, r, j, v, y, w, th, z, ch, qu, x, ng, nk, ay, ee, igh, ow, oo, ar, or to build words and write simple sentences.
