Class Topic: Secret Garden

This half term, we will be exploring local habitats and using simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of our school and its grounds. We will also go on a bug hunt and record and identify the small animals that we find. We will organise the data that we collect on a

spreadsheet and create charts to analyse the data.

Science: Plants and Growth Care

In this unit, children will be encouraged to think more scientifically about how and why plants grow as they do, as well as recognising the journey from seed to flowering plant. They will observe plant growth and set fair tests with variables to understand the best conditions for growth.

<u>Maths:</u>

Children in Year 1 will be learning about position and direction.

We will then move on to place value within 100, money and finally time.



Children in Year 2 will learn how to tell the time to o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to and finally how to tell the time in 5 minute intervals. Next, we will move on to measuring mass, capacity and volumes of liquid, as well as recording temperatures on a thermometer.

<u>English:</u>

Children in Year 1 will be reading the book 'The Secret Sky Garden' by Linda Sarah and Fiona Lumbers. We will be making predictions and responding to illustrations. We will also be using adjectives to write character descriptions.



The Hodgeheg

Children in Year 2 will be reading the book 'The Hodgeheg' by Dick King Smith. We will be making predictions and responding to illustrations, using our 'minds eye' to visualize and interpret the text as well as writing in role and story telling.



This term, we start the unit 'Changing Me.' We will explore changes to our bodies by thinking about what happens as we get older.

ART:

This term, we will be using different textures to create a collograph plate in the form of a flower. We will look at the work of a range of key artists and experiment with their approaches.

How to help at home.

Your child's reading book will be changed every **Friday** and they will keep the same reading book for the week. Please listen to your child read their book as often as possible. Listening to your child re-read the same book helps with their reading fluency and confidence. Please write a comment in your child's reading record each time they read to show how they are getting on with the book they have been given. Please also encourage them to retell the story that they read or explain they key events.
