Seasons

Learning about the seasons will continue throughout the year. We will be learning about seasonal changes and key features of Autumn. The children can discover natural Autumn resources in our investigation area.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

'Ourselves' - we will be learning about our bodies and our senses. We will be doing lots of activities about our favourite people and places.



Reception Maths:

- Getting to know you
- Match, sort and compare matching pictures and objects, sorting objects and comparing amounts.
- Talk about measure and patterns - comparing size, mass and capacity, exploring and creating simple patterns.

Reception Literacy:


The children will be learning stories though 'Talk Through Stories'. We will be reading the stories frequently to get to know them really well and learning the vocabulary in them. The stories this term are: The Rainbow Fish, Perfectly Norman, and Ruby's Worry.

Phonics: We will be teaching Phonics using the Read, Write Inc scheme. This half term the children will learn the sounds: m,a,s,d,t,i,n,p,g,o,c,k,u,b,f,e,l,h,r,j.

Name writing: Children will practise recognising and writing their name each day.

Physical Development:

- Getting dressed and undressed.
- Moving around the hall.
- Using the outdoor area climbing on the climbing frame and using the bikes.

Creative Development:Using paint to create

different pieces of art.

- Cutting and sticking to create a collage.
 - Self-portraits.
- Autumnal pictures.



How parents can help at home: Please help your child to recognise and begin to write their name - put name cards around the house or write their name on snacks! Share stories, songs and rhymes at home. Practise counting objects at home. It could be cereal, shoes, people, anything! Talk about how old your child is now and how old they will be on their next birthday.
