The children will be learning stories though 'Talk Through Stories'. We will be reading the stories frequently to get to know them really well and learning the vocabulary in them. The stories this term are: Room on the Broom, Owl Babies and Stick Man.

**Phonics:** We will be teaching Phonics using the Read, Write Inc scheme. This half term the children will consolidate/learn the sounds: m,a,s,d,t,i,n,p,g,o,c,k,u,b,f,e,l,h,r,j, v, y, w, th, z, ch, qu, x, ng, nk.

**Name writing:** Children will continue to practise recognising and writing their name each day.
