Class Topic: Around the World! Knowledge and Understanding of the World Reception will be exploring the world around us this half term. Exploring winter weather. What do we wear in Winter? What does our environment We will look at Winter weather, explore the changes in our look like in Winter? Celebrating Chinese New Year. What do environment and compare to the Polar regions. the celebrations look like? What food do We will be celebrating Chinese New Year and finding out about people eat? the dances and food. We will also be exploring different Exploring different countries. What is it like in different countries? How does it countries and comparing them to where we live. compare to where we live?

Maths: English: The children will be learning stories though 'Talk Through Stories'. Exploring numbers to 8. We will be reading the stories frequently to get to know them really Finding 1 more and 1 less. well and learning the vocabulary in them. The stories this term are: One Snowy Night, Lost and Found and Exploring the composition of numbers to 8. Handa's Hen. Doubles to 8. Combining 2 groups. **Phonics:** Children will continue learning letter sounds and how to blend and segment words. They will continue to practice m, a, s, d, t, i, Exploring and comparing length, height n, g, o, c, k, u, b, f, e, l, h, sh, r, j, v, y, w, th, z, ch, qu, x, ng, nk and build words with these sounds. Eg. s-a-t, sat, b-u-g bug. and time. Name writing: Children will practise recognising and writing their name each day.
