History:

We will be exploring flight and travel. Children will learn who the Wright brothers were and why they were so significant.

Maths:

In year 1, children will be continuing their learning on numbers within 20. We will be continuing with addition and subtraction within 20 before moving onto place value within 50. We will also be learning about length and height towards the end of the term.

In year 2, children will be continuing with the multiplication and division topic before beginning their units on measurement including length and height, and mass, temperature and capacity.

DT:

Children will follow a design criteria to create a stable structure using different tools and equipment. Children will begin to use the iterative design cycle through designing, testing and evaluating their product.


Science:

Everyday Materials

In this unit, children are continuing their learning around everyday materials. We will be building a structure which can withstand wind. We will explore waterproof materials. Children will identify suitable materials for different objects.

English:

In English, key stage 1 are reading The Adventures of Egg Box dragon by Richard Adams. We will continue to focus on our development of transcription by writing sentences containing known phonics sounds. We will be taking part in lots of different writing opportunities through shared and modelled writing including personal narratives, instructions, persuasive writing and information writing.

In this unit, children explore making healthy life choices and why this is important. We will also explore medicine safety and road safety.

RE:

How and why people pray

In this unit, we will be exploring the importance of prayer for some people and religions.
