Class Topic: Why do we remember the Romans?

Our big question this half term is 'Why do we remember the Romans?' and in this unit we will be exploring the Roman Army and why it was so successful and the impact that the

Roman empire had on Britain. We will also be understanding who Boudica was and why they led a rebellion against the Romans.

Science: Sound

This unit 'Sound' takes children on a journey where they learn how sounds are made, how sound travels through to the ear, volume and pitch. Children will also be exploring sounds from near and far.

Maths:

In Maths we will initially be continuing with Money and time and later moving on to graphs, charts and shapes, with flashbacks including shapes, lengths and additions.

In Year 3, we will be focusing on time and Roman numerals later moving onto shape and time.

In Year 4, we will be focusing on graphs and charts and how these translate into data and information.

English:

This half-term we will be reading the story 'Escape from Pompeii' by Christina Balit. In this book we will be following the story of two young children and their experience of living in Pompeii when Mount Vesuvius erupted.



Throughout this story, the children will: make predictions, research about Pompeii and the eruption and create an eye-witness account.
